

DO UTIEL-REQUENA MEDIA KIT

We are Utiel-Requena, a Designation of Origin (DO) of wine located in the inner of Valencian Community, 70 km away from Mediterranean Sea. We are one of the older DD. OO of Spain, because of our foundation was in 1932 and our vineyard tradition meets 2,600 years of history.

Our region is formed by nine municipalities: Caudete de las Fuentes, Camporrobles, Fuenterrobles, Requena, Siete Aguas, Sinarcas, Utiel, Venta del Moro y Villargordo del Cabriel.

Utiel-Requena is formed by **109 wineries and 4,213 winegrowers**. With a land of **30,484 hectares** in production, it is the more extensive vineyard of the Valencian Community. Furthermore, in our demarcation there are the **77% of the ecological vineyard** of Valencian Community.

Regarding varieties, our DO has **12 red grapes and 14 whites**, being the Bobal and Tardana, respectively, the native varieties of the region. **The Bobal grape in our flagship variety**. We have 18.967 hectares of it and it supposes the 62% of the total. Also, a 40% of the Bobal hectares are from old vineyards, meaning they have more than 50 years old.

We have a Mediterranean climate with a continental feature due to its average altitude of 720 metres, which means high fluctuations between day at night, as well as between summer and winter.

The last data reflect a production of 159 million of kg of grape with an excellent qualification of the vintage.

Our headquarters are in the [Museum of Wine-Round Winery](#), an emblematic building in Utiel converted in a regional wine museum. You can visit it free and, moreover, we have a guide in the weekends.

The Designation of Origin are crucial figures because fix population, generate employment, boots worthy worker opportunities and project a future for the new generations.

For all these data, **wine is the economic engine in the Utiel-Requena region.**
